Oh, how did you milk her?

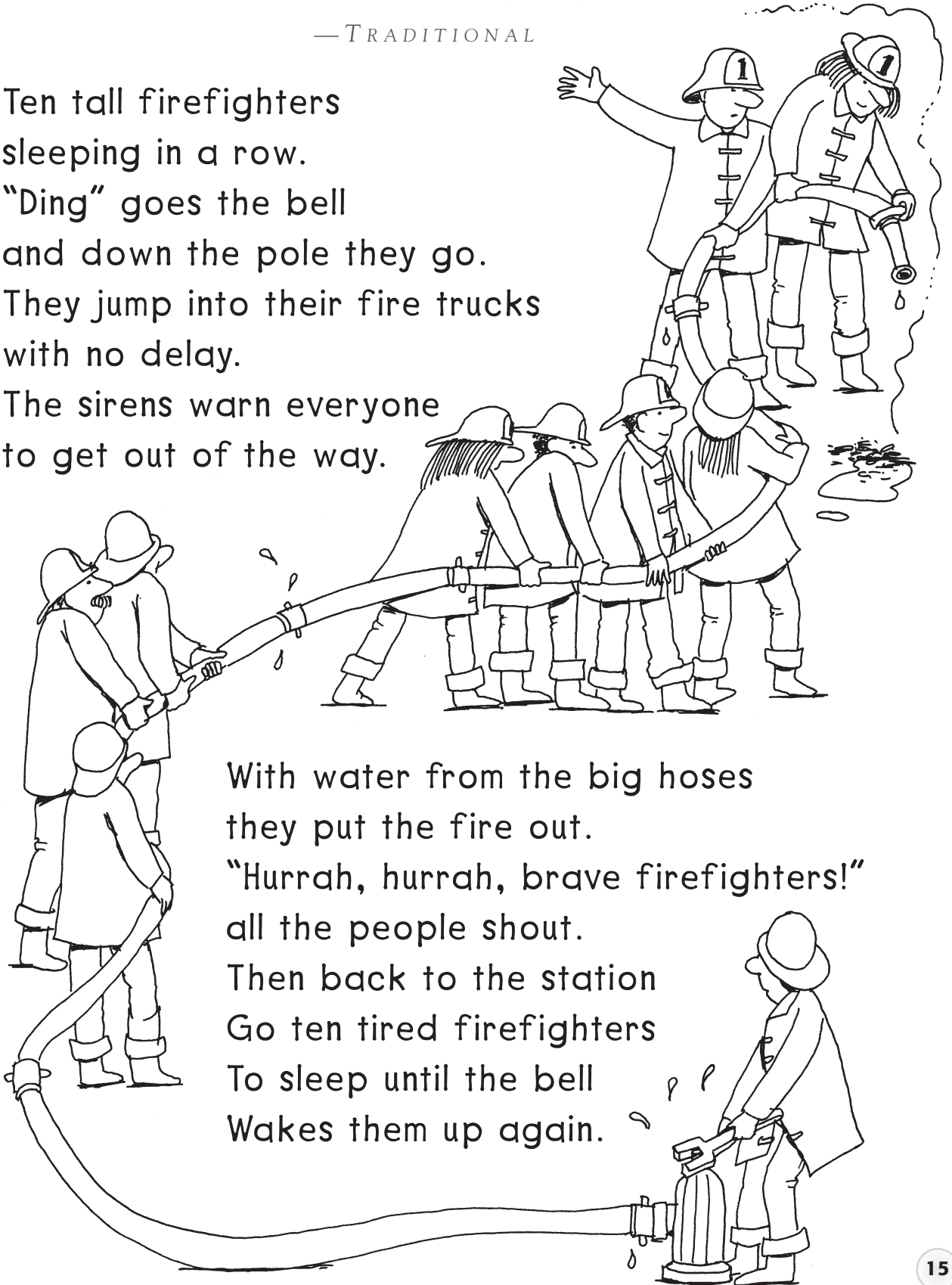

And stop right away!"

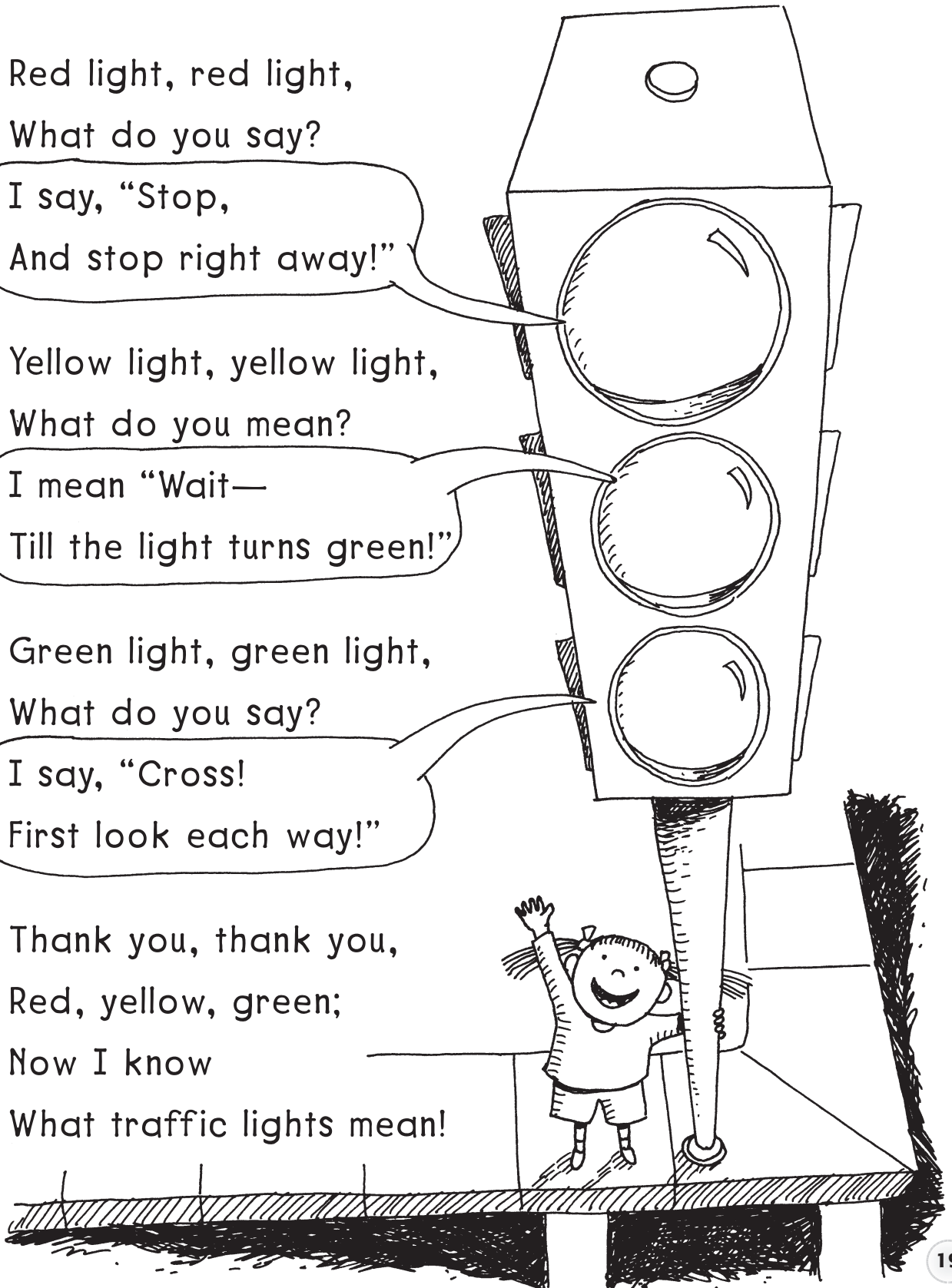
Yellow light, yellow light,
