



# MS. MIRANDA-MATH

## Common Core State Standards

- Understand that the three digits of a three-digit number represent amounts of hundreds, tens, and ones; e.g., 706 equals 7 hundreds, 0 tens, and 6 ones.
- Fluently add and subtract within 100 using strategies based on place value, properties of operations, and/or the relationship between addition and subtraction.
- Measure the length of an object by selecting and using appropriate tools such as rulers, yardsticks, meter sticks, and measuring tapes.
- Use addition and subtraction within 100 to solve one- and two-step word problems involving situations of adding to, taking from, putting together, taking apart, and comparing, with unknowns in all positions, e.g., by using drawings and equations with a symbol for the unknown number to represent the problem.

Measure: Scholars will complete Number of the Day and a Math Work Page given a 20 minute time period.

Objective: Scholars will be able to solve addition and subtraction equations that use the word About or Estimate.

Measure: Scholars will receive an 80% or better on their check in About assessment.
